Accept as Final the decision of the Show Judge on any questions arising and agree to hold the Show, their officials, directors and employees harmless for any action taken.

***** RULES*****

1. Equine Canada rules apply as closely as possible and at the discretion of the show committee.
2. All riders must wear approved headgear and footwear, as required by E.C. rules.
3. Age of riders determined as of January 1, 2024.
4. Lead Line and Walk/Trot/Jog riders eligible for other classes (at the discretion of the parent or guardian.)
5. All competitors must have individual insurance or obtain Foley Agricultural Society membership (\$5.00 per year) which will be included on your registration entry fees.
6. Western horses ridden in a curb leverage bit must be ridden with 1 hand.
7. Judge's decision is final.
