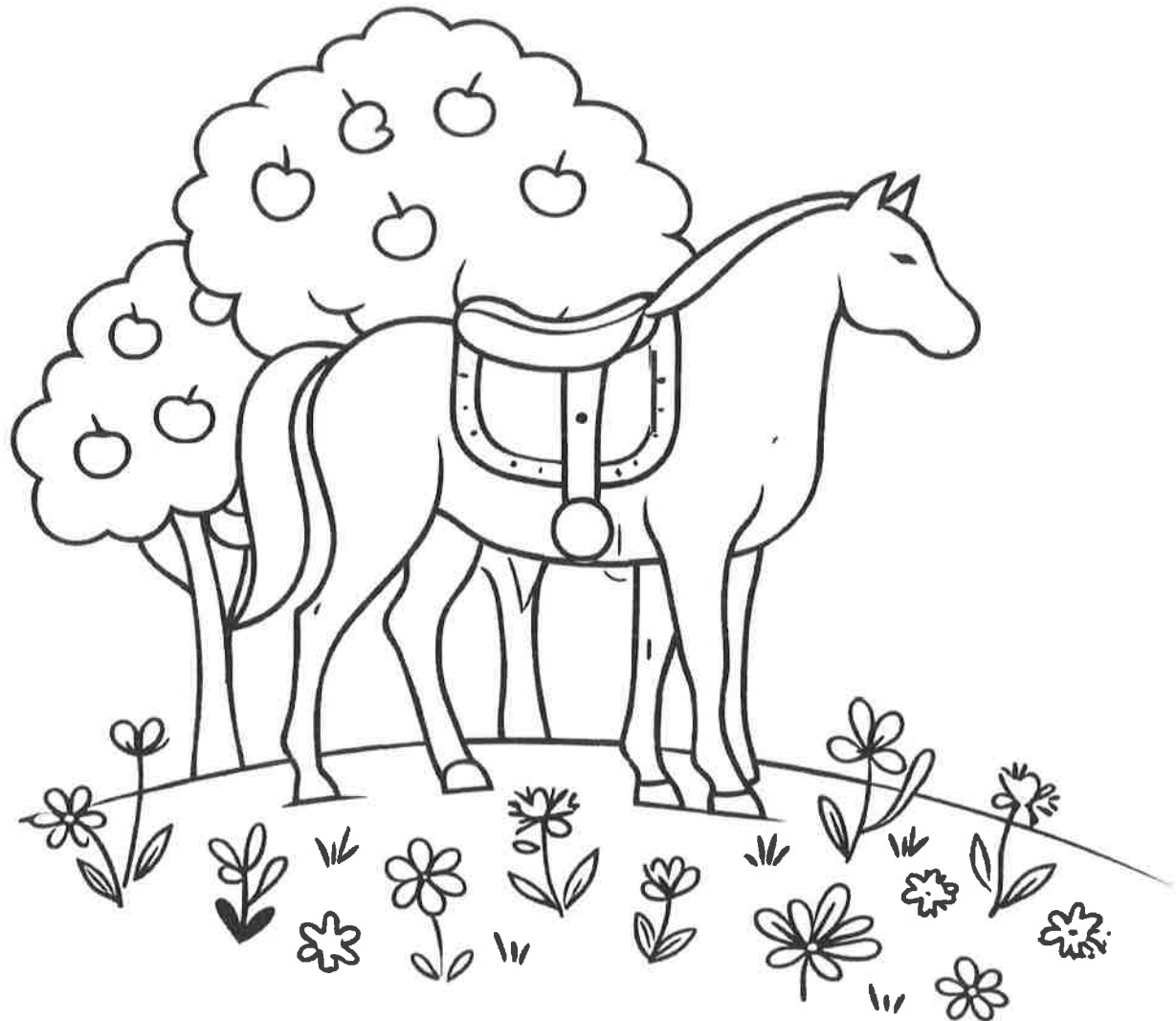

RULES & REGULATIONS FOR EXHIBITORS:

1. An exhibit fee of \$5.00 entitles the holder to membership in the Society for the current year and to receive an admission ticket to the Fair. The Society will retain \$5.00 from all exhibitors who win \$5.00 or more, as a membership for the following year.
2. You may pick up tags at the Thrift Shop at the Coop any Saturday between 10 and 2 or at a Seguin library. Alternatively, you may contact Janet at jborneman@vianet.ca or by telephone at 705-378-1438 to make arrangements to pick up tags.
3. All exhibits must be brought to the Foley Community Centre **Thursday, September 3, 2026 between 9 a.m.- 9 p.m.** All exhibits must remain in the Hall until Sunday, and can be picked up between 10 a.m. — 2:00 pm. The Hall will be secured at all times, when unattended. Please note that if you have more than a couple of exhibits, you must be at the Hall no later than 8:30 p.m. in order to have time to process your exhibits.
4. All exhibits must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor to entitle them to receive a prize and must be made within the last 12 months. Articles soiled or worn are **NOT** eligible for competition.
5. No article will be permitted unless names, initials or distinguishing marks are **covered.**
6. All articles are to be handmade and must be free of all odors, including smoke, moth balls and mould. Any article with any odor will be disqualified before competition and will not be judged. No plants, flowers or vegetables with bugs will be accepted. A Board Member on behalf of the Society reserves the right to accept or reject ANY entry.
7. No persons will be admitted to the Hall during Judging except the Officers duly appointed to attend.
8. Any exhibitor removing any of their exhibits from the Hall prior to closing on Sunday will forfeit the right to prize money. Exhibits can be picked up Sunday, September 6, 2026 between 10 am and 2 pm.
9. No person shall in any way interfere with the judges or the judging.
10. If any article is entered in any class to which it does not belong, the judges

are not to award it a prize, no matter what its merits may be.

11. While the Board will take every reasonable precaution to ensure the safety of the exhibits, by entering their exhibit, the exhibit owner agrees to release and hold harmless the Foley Agricultural Society, its Directors, Officers, employees, volunteers and all others associated with the Fair and its activities in the event any exhibit is damaged, lost or stolen.
12. All judging will take place on the Friday of the Fair, in the Hall. Judge's decision is final. If only one (1) exhibit appears in a section, that exhibit does not necessarily win a prize. Prizes will be awarded on merit.
13. All exhibitors are requested to send a list of prizes and an estimate of money won, to Janet Borneman within seven (7) days following the Fair.
14. All prize money may be picked up at the **Awards Pot Luck on Saturday, September 19, 2026 at 6:00 pm.** Monies not picked up on Awards Night will be mailed in the form of a cheque, payable to the exhibitor. **Children's monies are in the form of cash and will not be mailed. Please make arrangements for pick up at another time or designate someone to pick up in your place.** Please tender all cheques on or before October 31st of the current year.
15. Claims of clerical errors must be made and received no later than five (7) days after the Fair.
16. Protests, if any, shall be made in writing to the Board and received within 48 hours of the closing of the Fair in order to be considered.
17. No selling of exhibits will be permitted.
18. Each Agricultural Society is entitled to enter a quilt in the District Competition for the "Ontario Association of Agricultural Societies". The special rules and regulations are posted on our website:

19. Only ONE (1) entry per person will be allowed under each SECTION in a Class.
20. Unless otherwise indicated, one piece will mean a unit (i.e. one dish towel);

a pair (i.e. a pair of mittens) or a set (i.e. baby booties, hat and sweater).

21. Entries in Sewing, Knitting and Crochet classes must attach a sample of the fabric/fibre/wool to the entry tag.

22. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to complete the entry form.

23. Unless otherwise stated, the prize money for children's competitions is as follows:

1st = \$2.00, 2nd = \$1.75, 3rd = \$1.50, 4th = \$1.00, 5th = \$0.75, 6th = \$0.50. 7th = \$0.25, 8th = \$ 0.25

JUNIOR PRIZE LIST 2026-2030

PRIMARY Age 5 years and Under

ART & WRITING - max. size-approx. 23 x 30 cm- Attach tag to bottom right hand corner

1. Make a construction paper sunflower decorated with sunflower seeds.
2. Sponge Painting
3. Colour enclosed Colouring Page
4. Fruit or vegetable stamping picture
5. A picture made from cereal
6. Trace your arm and hand and decorate to look like a tree.
7. Draw a picture of Sparky the Fire Dog (Sponsored by Seguin Fire Services)

CRAFTS - no kits-attach tag to bottom right hand corner

7. Make a caterpillar using an egg carton
8. Decorate a Straw Hat
9. Make a bug that might be found in your garden using any medium.
10. Make a flower from coffee filters (decorate & include stem)
11. Make a necklace from edible material
12. Decorate a pine cone to look like a Christmas tree
13. Make a flower from buttons – no larger than 8 1/2" by 11"
14. Make a farm animal from play dough

SCIENCE – Attach Tag to containers or to bottom right hand corner

15. Flowers - 3 blooms grown from seed
16. Grow a vegetable plant in a plastic/paper cup (bean, pea)
17. Figure-made with vegetables
18. A collection of bugs in half an egg carton

BAKING - must be on disposable plate etc., and plastic covered-attach tag to plate. As only decorations are being judged, items may be store bought.

19. Large cookie-max 12 cm-decorated-decorations only to be judged
20. Decorate 2 cupcakes (judged on decorations only)
21. Gingerbread man-max 20cm- decorations only to be judged

JUNIOR Ages 6 and 7 years

ART & WRITING - max. size-approx. 23 x 30 cm- attach tag to bottom right hand corner

1. Colour the enclosed Colouring Page
2. Make a book mark with a Garden Theme (max. 2" x6")
3. Make a birthday card
4. Make a butterfly by drawing, colouring, painting or a combination.
5. Draw a picture of Sparky the Fire Dog (Sponsored by Seguin Fire Services)

SEWING & NEEDLEWORK - attach tag to article on bottom right hand corner

5. Decorate a ball cap
6. Picture made from scraps (wool, fabric, felt, etc.)
7. Any hand sewn article

CRAFTS - no kits-attach tag to bottom right hand corner

8. Decorate a flower pot
9. Make a garden stepping stone
10. Make a homemade musical instrument
11. Make a wind chime from any recycled material
12. Make a bird feeder from a 2 litre pop bottle
13. Decorate a hair band.
14. Make and decorate a paper weight using any material
15. Make a picture frame from popsicle sticks.

SCIENCE – Attach Tag to containers or to bottom right hand corner

16. Flowers -3 blooms grown from seed
17. Vegetables -3 vegetables grown from seed
18. Figure-made from vegetables
19. Make a bird feeder using a pinecone and seeds

BAKING - must be on disposable plate etc., and plastic covered-attach tag to plate

20. Rice Cereal Squares- 3
21. Drop Cookies-unbaked - 3
22. Decorate a donut (decorations only to be judged, donut may be store bought)

INTERMEDIATE Ages 8, 9 and 10 years

ART & WRITING - max. size-approx. 23 x 30 cm- attach tag to bottom right hand corner

1. Colour the enclosed Colouring page.
2. Pencil crayon drawing of my favourite garden animal.
3. Write a poem about your garden.
4. Make a mosaic sun catcher using tissue paper.
5. Draw a picture of Sparky the Fire Dog (Sponsored by Seguin Fire Services)

SEWING & NEEDLEWORK - attach tag to article on bottom right hand corner

5. Create a stuffed toy by sewing, knitting or crocheting
6. Make and decorate a hand puppet from a sock
7. Sew and decorate a reusable grocery bag

CRAFTS - no kits-attach tag to bottom right hand corner

8. Create a car using a box no larger than a tissue box
9. Make and decorate a garden stepping stone
10. Create a garden scene in a shoe box lid – may be real or artificial.
11. Make an article using duct tape
12. Make a piece of hand made jewellery using any medium
13. Tye Dye a t-shirt
14. Make a bookmark with a farm theme

BAKING - must be on disposable plate etc., and plastic covered-attach tag to plate

15. Make and decorate a sugar cookie shaped like a flower (no cookie cutters) no bigger than a paper plate
16. Decorated cupcakes -3
17. Oatmeal cookies -3

SCIENCE - Attach Tag to containers or to bottom right hand corner

18. Dress up a cob of corn to look like a scarecrow
19. Flowers-3 blooms grown from seed
20. Vegetables-3 vegetables grown from seed
21. Collection from nature of 5 items named and displayed
22. Make a Mr. Potato Head using a real potato

PHOTOGRAPHY - Digital or 35mm. Pictures may be 4"x6" or 5" x 7" colour unless otherwise specified mounted individually on cardstock or cardboard with a 3 cm. border. Photos must be taken within last 12 months. Attach tag to right side of photo

SENIOR Ages 11, 12 and 13 years (may be over 13 but not in high school)

ART & WRITING - max. size-approx. 23 x 30 cm- attach tag to bottom right hand corner

1. Write a poem about a garden.
2. Make a collage of a garden – can be drawn or cut-outs.
3. Pencil or charcoal sketch-your choice of subject
4. Draw a picture of Sparky the Fire Dog (Sponsored by Seguin Fire Services)

SEWING & NEEDLEWORK - attach tag to article on bottom right hand corner

4. Sew and stuff (no kits) any item not to exceed 12" x 12"
5. Hand made belt (any medium)
6. Sew, knit or crochet a fashion accessory

CRAFTS - no kits-attach tag to bottom right hand corner

7. Decorate a jar or bottle suitable for a vase
8. Make a treasure box (not to exceed 10 cm. x 15 cm.) must be able to open
9. Make a welcome sign
10. Make a friendship bracelet from any medium
11. Make an article using duct tape.
12. Build a log cabin or barn from any medium
13. Make a farm tractor from Lego
14. Make a farm animal mask using paper mache

SCIENCE - Attach Tag to containers or to bottom right hand corner

15. Flowers -, 3 stems, any colour, grown from seed
16. Vegetables - 3, named, grown from seed
17. An arrangement of wildflowers in a recycled container not to exceed 12" high
18. Build a worm composter (instructions available on website)

BAKING - must be on disposable plate etc., and plastic covered-attach tag to plate

19. Banana muffins – 3 – include recipe
20. Make Trail Mix with pumpkin seeds as one ingredients
21. Pieces of fudge -3

PHOTOGRAPHY– digital or 35mm. Pictures may be 4"x 6"or 5"x 7" colour unless otherwise specified and mounted individually on cardstock or cardboard with a 3 cm. border. Must be taken in last 12 months. Attach tag to right side of photo.

ART & WRITING – approx. 23x30 cm. Attach TAG to bottom right hand corner!

1. Soap Carving
2. Portrait of My Best Friend – hand drawn
3. Garden scene – colour pencil
4. Acrylic landscape – no larger than 10" x 15"
5. Watercolour Sunset – no larger than 8" x 11"
6. Original poem or song lyrics
7. Design a cookbook cover
8. Draw a picture of Sparky the Fire Dog (Sponsored by Seguin Fire Services)

SEWING & NEEDLEWORK – Attach Tag on bottom right hand corner

8. Needlecraft – knit (hand or machine), crocheted, latch hook, embroidery, etc. article of your choice
9. Sewing – Pyjama pants (hand or machine)
10. Create an article from an old pair of jeans
11. Handmade belt – any medium.

CRAFTS – attach Tag to bottom right hand corner

12. Make an article of jewellery (no kits)
13. Wreath for any season
14. Ceramic or clay work – 1 piece
15. Make your own bath product – attach your instructions
16. Any useful item from recycled material
17. Make a robot from tin cans

SCIENCE – Attach Tag to containers or to bottom right hand corner

18. Floral arrangement in a teacup & saucer
19. Framed picture using real pressed and mounted flowers, weeds, leaves, etc.
20. Most unusual shaped vegetable
21. Single bloom in a container – named
22. Create a meal plan for a day

BAKING- no mixes, must have plastic covering – attach TAGS to plate.

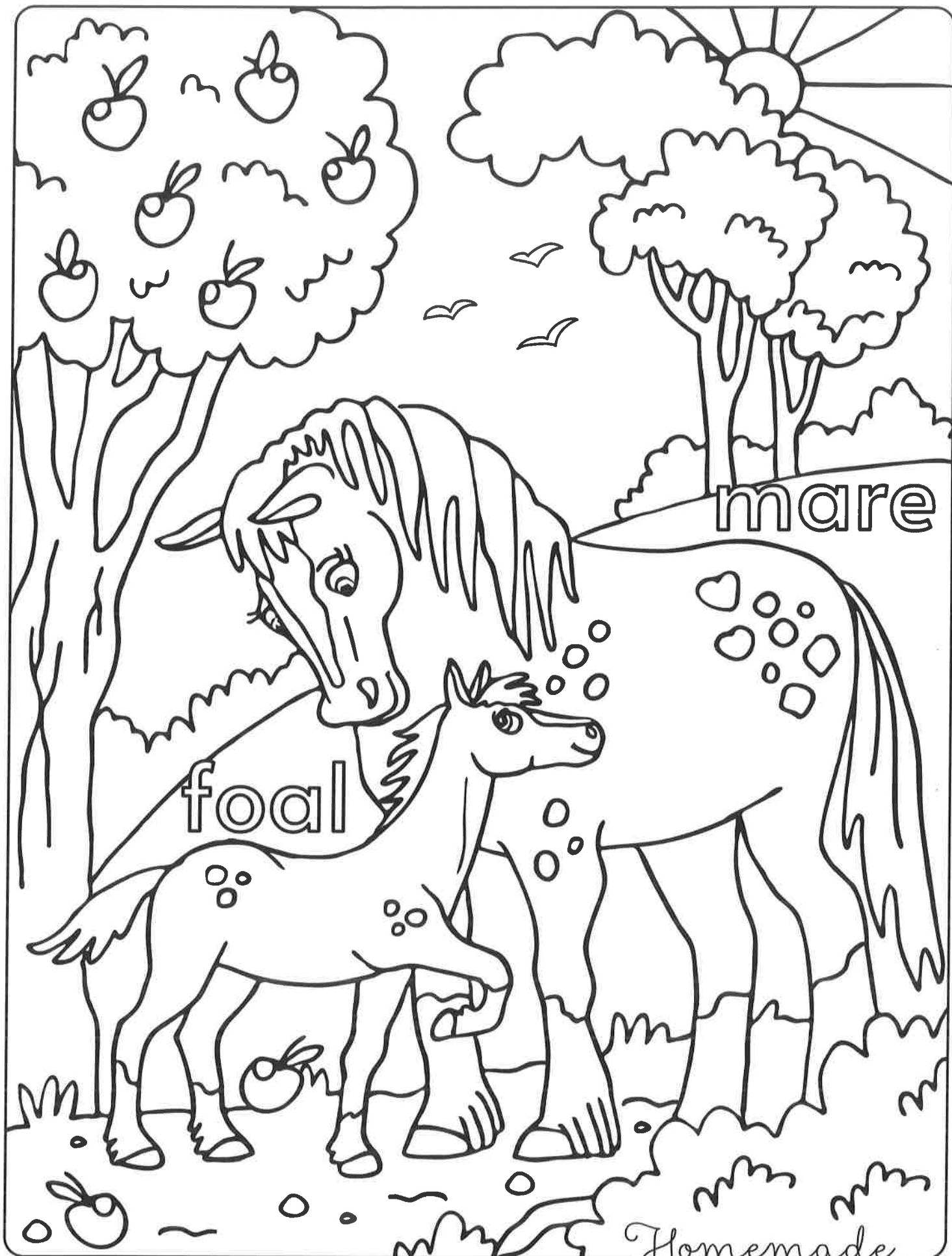
23. Best home made bread (recipe attached)- may use a bread maker

26. Muffins, your choice (recipe attached) -3
